Albert Nelson Condit, 92 of Morganton died Saturday, January 27, 2007. Nelson was born on April 5, 1914 to the late Anna Lindsley Condit and Albert Emmons Condit and was raised in suburban New Jersey. He served in the U. S. Navy in WWII as a Pharmacist's mate in Scotland. He was employed by the American Can Company for over forty years. His beloved wife, Peggy left this world eleven years ago, leaving a hole in his heart. He was also preceded in death by his brothers, John and Orland.
