Alton James Tallent, 83, of Morganton died Friday, June 21, 2013 following a period of declining health. He was born in Burke County on April 5, 1930 and was a son of P. W. and Bessie Jane Hudson Tallent. Mr. Tallent was a U. S. Army veteran serving in Germany as a truck driver during the Korean conflict. For 36 years, he was a long distance and local truck driver for Carolina Freight and retired in 1990. He was a member of Cross Memorial Baptist Church where he served in many church positions including as deacon, and he loved being the church bus driver on church excursions throughout the southeast.
