Alton William Washburn, 95, of Morganton, NC went home to be with the Lord on the morning of February 7, 2022. Born August 7, 1926 in Holyoke, MA, he was the son of the late Ralph and Fannie (Clements) Washburn.

Al served his country in the US Navy during World War II. He and his late wife, Doris, were instrumental in establishing a Baptist church in Enfield, CT where they raised their three children. An avid student of the Bible, Al taught adult Bible classes and continued to do so in his retirement; first in Hendersonville, NC and later at Burkemont Baptist Church in Morganton.
