Arvel Herley Baker, 79, of Hickory, NC died Thursday, December 30, 2010 at Catawba Valley Medical Center following a month-long illness. Born in Wilkes County, NC on December 6, 1931, he was the son of the late Zee Baker and Callie Claire Sparks Baker. Arvel was a member of Mountain View Baptist Church.
