Cecil "Pawpaw" Pinkney Kincaid, 98, of Morganton, NC went to his home in Heaven on Thursday, May 19, 2016. Born in Burke County, NC on August 16, 1917, he was the son of the late James Kincaid and Mary Jane Bean Kincaid. Cecil helped organize and start El Bethel Baptist Church and was the oldest charter member. He served as the elected director of the Baptist Training Union in 1944, deacon, Sunday school director, Sunday school teacher, on the Pastor Search Committee, and in the choir. Mr. Kincaid had worked at the Old Morganton Shop, Drexel Heritage, and retired from Henredon after 35 years.
