Douglas Howard Clark, 58, of Nolan Wood Heights, Morganton, NC died Tuesday, April 3, 2007, at his residence. He was born in Caldwell County, NC on May 17, 1948 and was a son of the late Theodore Roosevelt Clark and Cordia Berry Clark. In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by brothers, Emory Delion Clark and Rev. T. R. Clark, Jr. Mr. Clark was a U. S. Army veteran of the Vietnam War and served with the 1st and 8th Calvary from 1968 to 1969. As a Sgt. First Class he was an expert rifleman and received the Bronze Star and two Purple Hearts.
