Rev. Elizabeth "Beth" Bean Henderson, 82, of Edgewood Ave, Morganton, NC, died Monday, May 21, 2007 at Grace Heights Nursing Center following a period of declining health. Born in Burke County, NC, on August 27, 1924, she was the daughter of the late Walter E. Bean and Martha Whisenant Bean. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Rev. Lawson P. Henderson; a brother, Rev. Ed Bean; and a sister, Katherine Vines. Beth was a devoted pastor's wife.
