Estelene Dale Melton, 92, of Hickory, NC, passed away on December 3, 2022.

Born at the family home in the Salem Community on November 11, 1930, she was the daughter of the late Grover Dockery Dale and Cora Elizabeth Dale. Estelene was a member of Glen Alpine United Methodist Church where she was a former trustee, past president of the UM Women's Circle, and was a member of various other committees. She was also active in the Morganton Garden Club, AARP, served for several years as president of the Burke County Home Extension Club, and was a volunteer at the History Museum of Burke County.

A graduate of Morganton High School, she worked for 20 years as an insurance agent and later at Burke United Christian Ministries and American Red Cross.
