It was rare seeing him without a favorite car or truck to roll across his wheelchair tray table. One of the highlights of his year was the gingerbread house that his sister Rebecca would make for him at Christmas. Even as he got older and had certain food restrictions, the staff made adjustments so as not to interrupt this lifelong tradition of being able to eat some of his gingerbread house.

Gary's smile was contagious and he had a way of endearing himself to all who met him. He was well loved and he gave much love in return to all who were fortunate enough to interact with him.

Gary was a strong individual and lived three times longer than expected when he was first diagnosed with cerebral palsy. He will be missed by so many.
