Gay Gladys Dills Patton

July 29, 1918 - Jan. 16, 2015

Mrs. Laurence Ray Patton passed away on Friday, January 16, 2015, in Black Mountain, NC. A 48 year resident of Morganton, NC, Mrs. Patton was 96 years old. Mrs. Patton was born Gay Gladys Dills on July 29, 1918, to John Floyd Dills, Sr. and Zena Lowery Dills in Nantahala, NC. The eldest of ten children, she met Laurence Ray Patton in Swannanoa, NC. They married two months later, on February 27, 1937. Gay and "Curly" were married nearly 61 years and produced thirty-one offspring in four generations so far. Granny and Papa also provided for countless others over the years.

Mrs. Patton worked with the Girl Scouts of America for 26 years, leading her troops in primitive camping techniques. She was a 4-H Leader as well, and travelled to Washington, DC, as a representative of that organization. Mrs. Patton also served as a commander in the DAV Auxiliary.
