Grace Melinda Bolding Sides, 88, of the Chesterfield Community, died unexpectedly, Monday, June 4, 2007, at her residence. She's been referred to as an "angel on earth", an "angel of mercy", an "angel of love", and just "an all around angel" that someone would have been blessed to know. Surviving are her daughter, Marie Sides Carden, and her husband, Eddie, of Durham, NC; a son "not by birth, but by love", Troy Patton and his wife, Joann, of Morganton; grandsons, Robert and Wade Griffin both of Durham; step-grandson, Ed Carden and his wife, Angela; and step-great granddaughter, Ashlyn Carden, all of Mebane, NC; numerous nephews and nieces; and a host of friends. Grace's grandsons were really her ultimate reason for

living. They made her happy simply by walking in the door, and they made her smile when nothing else could. She was a second "Mother" to Robert and Wade. Grace took great pride in showing these boys off, so she made sure they would go with her to church, cookouts, senior citizens meetings, family reunions, or just to visit a neighbor.
