Harvey "Boyd" Fletcher, 98, of Morganton Long Term Care went home to be with the Lord and can hear now after being deaf all his life. Born in Watauga County on December 18, 1913, he was the son of the late Spencer Fletcher and Rosa Harmon Fletcher. Boyd retired from Henredon Furniture in 1979, after thirty years of service.
