Luther Gideon "L.G." Sink, Jr., 85, of Bethel Road, Morganton, NC, died Wednesday, December 13, 2006 at College Pines Health & Rehabilitation Center following several months of declining health. Born December 3, 1921 in Lexington, NC, he was the son of the late Luther Gideon Sink, Sr. and Sallie Cross Sink.
