Paul Michael Braun, 55, of Morganton, NC passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, January 3, 2017. Paul enjoyed music and playing the harmonica and having fellowship with his friends at Fonta Flora in Morganton. He was an avid outdoorsman who loved hiking, camping and spending time doing anything outdoors.

In addition to his mother, Mr. Braun is survived by his wife, Mary Hull Braun of the home; a son, Cory Braun and his wife, Samantha; a daughter, Mary Faye Lyle; grandsons, Zachary and Jack; siblings, William Braun, Kathleen Braun, Suzanne Duncan and husband, Bobby, Anthony Braun and wife, Sandy, and Loretta Braun; and a number of nieces and nephews.
