Wesley Pink "Freddie" Cox, 99, of Morganton, NC died Friday, June 3, 2016. Born in Burke County, NC on March 11, 1917, he was the son of the late Pinkney Henderson and Julie Cox. Freddie was a member of Zion Baptist Church. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy and was considered to be one of the top timber men in the country.
