Alice Dunlap Sakowski, 98, of Morganton died Sunday, March 2, 2014. She was born in Stanly County on October 20, 1915 and was the daughter of the late Lucius Victor Dunlap and Margaret Ethel Bostian Dunlap. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Arthur T. "Art" Sakowski who died in 1997. Mrs. Sakowski earned a B. A. degree from Woman's College of Greensboro and went on to complete a post-baccalaureate certificate program from Katherine Gibbs in Boston.
