Bennie Crawford Greene, 74, of Morganton, NC, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on February 16, 2022 surrounded by his loving family.

Born to the late Verne and Nelle Crawford Greene on November 3, 1947, in Boone, North Carolina, Bennie had lived in Burke County most of his life.

Along with his parents, Bennie was preceded in death by his devoted wife of over 35 years, Linda Gantt Greene and brothers Richard and Sam Greene.

One of Bennie's proudest accomplishments in his life was serving his country in the United States Air Force for 8 ½ years, where he obtained the rank of Staff Sergeant. His favorite past times included doing landscape work, riding his Kubota tractor, and watching his grandson's wrestle.

Throughout his life, Bennie was a member and served at Mt. Home Baptist Church and Hopewell Baptist Church. Currently he and Jo worshipped and served together at Burkemont Baptist Church.

Those left to cherish his memory include his loving wife Ava Jo Mills Greene, daughters Lori Patton (Pat) and Wendy Hardin (Randy) both of Morganton; Bonus-son Bobby Wills (Angela) of Evans, GA.; and Bonus-daughter Amy West (Daniel) of Roanoke Rapids, N.C.
