Betty Laura Avery Kincaid, 87, peacefully transitioned from earth to glory, Saturday morning, April 29, 2017 at her home in Morganton, NC. She was born on May 15, 1929 to the late Gilmore Avery, Sr. and Lizzie Fleming Avery. In addition to her parents, she was also preceded in death by her husband, James Otis Kincaid; brothers, William H. Avery, Sr., and Gilmore Avery, Jr.

Moving from the Lake James Community to the Bristol Creek family residence located in the Chesterfield community, she attended the Corpening School in the Hartland community. She graduated from Olive Hill High School Class of 1945 where she was the Salutatorian and a member of the Olive Hill Choir. She attended Johnson C. Smith University in Charlotte, NC. At age 36, she began working for Broughton Hospital (the second African American Health Care Technician hired) and retired in 1993 after 28 years of dedicated service. She was also a member of the Ervin-Johnson Women's Missionary Society (former president), Ladies' Aide Club (former president), Senior Choir (former treasurer) and attended Sunday School. She was involved in community service and fellowshiped with friends as a former member of the Bethune Women's Civic Club and Willing Workers Club of Shiloh AME Church.
