After graduation, Bill enlisted in the N.C. Army National Guard (30th Old Hickory Division) where he served with distinction for 24 years until his retirement at the rank of Staff-Sargent (E-6). In addition to his career in the military, Bill had a long and successful career as an auto mechanic for various dealerships in the Morganton area before his retirement from Martin Family Ford. In addition to his work as a mechanic, Bill was an avid antique car collector and restorer.
