Byron Forgy, 88, of Morganton passed away Monday, January 14, 2013. Born in Muhlenberg County, KY on November 26, 1924, he was the son of the late Murray Forgy and Polly Rosser Forgy. During Byron's teen years, he starred on his high school basketball team in Auburn, KY. There he met Jean, his lifelong sweetheart.
