**Aug. 7, 1924 - May 16, 2006**

Carl Rogers, 81, of Conley Rd., Morganton, NC died Tuesday, May 16, 2006 at Burke Palliative Care Center in Valdese following a period of declining health. He was born August 7, 1924 in Burke County, NC, and was a son of the late James Mickler Rogers and Florence Fisher Rogers.
