Clayton Taylor, 71, of Morganton took his heavenly flight on Wednesday, June 13, 2018 while surrounded by his family. Born in Burke County, NC on May 26, 1947, he was the son of the late Luther Dale and Annie Azalee Taylor Icard. Clayton was an active member of Zion Baptist Church where he served as chairman of the Fellowship Hall Committee. He loved to cook and organized several fundraisers for the church and many other organizations in the community. He was engaged with the Freedom High School Booster Club as well as Oak Hill Junior High School and Table Rock Middle School. Clayton also participated in the Sheriff Barbecue every year.
