Doris Hill Sink, 95, died on July 4 at Autumn Care of Drexel after several years of declining health. Doris was born on June 9, 1926 in Lexington, NC to David Hill Swing and Mae Lohr Swing. She was married to her husband of 59 years, Luther G. Sink, Jr. on October 5, 1947.

Doris completed a business course at Lenoir Rhyne University and worked as a medical secretary at Broughton Hospital. She lived her adult life in Morganton, except for a one and a half year stay in Lexington when "LG" returned to active duty in the Army to serve in the Korean Conflict. A devoted wife and mother, she attended all of the children's school functions, drove them to all of their activities, and supervised daily homework.
