Forrest Ronnie Hudson, 67, of Morganton, NC passed away Tuesday, April 4, 2017. Born in Burke County, NC on June 2, 1949, he was the son of the late Forest Hudson and Vassie Denton Hudson. Ronnie was a member of El Bethel Baptist Church and Gideon International.

Ronnie retired as a Captain with the Morganton Department of Public Safety.
