Harley Allen "Tom" Cook, 59, of Hill Haven Circle, Morganton, NC, died unexpectedly Saturday, September 16, 2006 at his residence. Born in Avery County, NC, on November 11, 1946, he was the son of Lila Frances Johnson Durham and the late Harley Cook. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son, Billy Joe Cook, and a grandson, Roger Branch. Harley attended the Drexel Christian Center and was an avid fisherman.
