Harold B. Fisher, 87, of Morganton, NC died Thursday, December 10, 2015. Born in Burke County, NC on October 13, 1928, he was the son of the late Bennett Harold Fisher and Etta Reep Fisher. Mr. Fisher was a member of First Presbyterian Church. He was a graduate of Morganton High School and of Cleavenger Business College in Hickory, NC. He was a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean War.
