



# *Harry Lee Birchfield*

**July 31, 1918 - Feb. 22, 2007**

Harry Lee Birchfield, 88, loving husband, father, and grandfather, of Ruritan Dr., Morganton, NC went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Thursday, February 22, 2007, at Grace Hospital following a period of declining health. He was born in Haywood County, NC on July 31, 1918 and was a son of the late Lee Turner Birchfield and Eliza Reece Birchfield. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers and seven sisters. Mr. Birchfield was a U. S. Army veteran of World War II serving with the 7th Armored Division in Europe. He earned four bronze service stars for his war service in Northern France, the Battle of the Bulge-Ardenne Forest, the Rhineland, and Central Europe. Harry loved nature and the outdoors.
