Haskel "Hack" Gray Buff, 86, of Morganton passed peacefully from this life on May 4, 2018 at Mission Hospital in Asheville NC after a brave battle with illness. Hack was born on November, 11 1931 in Burke County to the late Major Ambrose Buff, Sr. and Mae Williams Buff. Hack grew up on his father's farm and worked in his father's store in Morganton. His father, Major A. Buff, Sr. was one of the largest cattle farmers in Burke County at the time. Hack's parents were devout Christians and raised their large family to be the same.
