Henry Sanders Rowland III, 88, died peacefully on August 29th in Morganton, NC. Henry was born on May 18th, 1934, in Hartford, CT. to Henry Sanders Rowland II and Helen Kenyon Rowland.

"Hank" is survived by his sister Polly of Hendersonville, N.C. His beautiful wife of 65 years Susan Rowland of Morganton, N.C. Children Frank, Fred, Bruce, Sarah and Eve. Rowland Designs was renowned for creating one-of-kind porcelain slip cast pottery. Hank was a master mold maker.

Henry was very active in numerous civic activities. He loved the comradery of the Elks Club, Morganton Rotary (past president 1991-92), Yoke Folks, BMW's Iron Butt Association, the Knobbies cycling club and Ham Radio International (handle: W9MY Mellow Yellow) to name just a few. One of Henry's proudest accomplishments was

serving in The American Red Cross, leading teams as they responded to national disasters. Henry was on the ground within hours of the September 11 terrorist attack on the Pentagon in Washington, D.C..

More than anything, Henry Rowland loved all living things. He collected friends, strangers and animals, alike. Bubba, Rumsfeld, Jagger, Lola, Rat Fink, Mama Kittie, Eddie, Fuzzball and the infamous Kao.
