James David "Jimmy" Walker, 75, of Morganton, NC died Sunday, June 21, 2015. Born in Cleveland County, NC on November 17, 1939, he was the son of the late James Bryon Walker and Ruby Hipps Walker. He was of the Baptist faith. James was a veteran of the N.C. Army National Guard, later served with the U.S. Air Force in Germany, and then served with the U. S. Air Force Reserve. He attained his solo pilot license and was an avid motorcyclist for many years. He loved to travel and listen to country music. James began his telecommunications career with Southern Bell, which later became Bellsouth then AT&T, from which he retired after 32 years of service.

Mr. Walker is survived by his wife of 50 years, Kaye Stroupe Walker of the home; daughters, Dana Weaver and her husband, Jason, of Charlotte, NC and Tracy Furtado and her husband, Mark, of Live Oak, TX; and a number of nephews and nieces.
