



## *Jesse Lee Parker*

**June 27, 1936 - March 30, 2012**

Jesse Lee Parker, 75, of Morganton, NC, passed away Friday, March 30, 2012, following a long and courageous battle with myelofibrosis. Born in Burke County, NC, on June 27, 1936, he was the son of the late William Andrew "Bill" Parker and Nadie Chapman Parker.
