John Ervin Denton, 78, of Morganton, NC went to be with his Lord and Savior on Sunday, September 20, 2015. Born in Burke County, NC on September 3, 1937, he was the son of the late Forrest Elbert Denton and Annie Mae Thacker Denton. John was a member of Mull's Grove Baptist Church where he had served as church custodian for 30 years, choir director for 40 years, and was a Sunday school teacher for 45 years.
