John Laxton Logan, Sr. 87, died Monday, June 21, 2010 following a brief illness. He was born in Rutherford County, N.C. on November 11, 1922 and was a son of the late Clifford M. and Minnie Beam Logan. Mr. Logan was a U. S.
