Joseph "Joe" Manson Carver, Jr., 76, of Morganton died Tuesday, June 19, 2018 after a long, courageous battle with leukemia. Born in Haywood County, NC on September 5, 1941, he was the son of the late Joseph Manson Carver, Sr. and Francis Mabel Lucille Arrington Carver. Joe was a member of Salem United Methodist Church.
