Norida lived a long, full, and loving life of 88 years, just days shy of her 89th birthday, and will be remembered most for her strength, her kindness, and the deep love she had for her family.

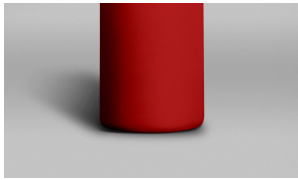
