Margaret T. Ingram, 87, of Morganton, NC died December 25, 2018, with her daughter at her side. Born in Cleveland County, NC on January 1, 1931, she was the daughter of the late Blaine Toney and Villa Toney.

Margaret was the new year baby for Cleveland county in 1931. Her fishing successes included a state record flounder for which she received two beautiful trophies.

Margaret regularly attended St. Mary's Episcopal Church for many years and loved her church community. She loved people, and her eyes lit up anytime she saw a baby or young child. She had an intense curiosity about anything and everything and sought to increase her knowledge at every opportunity. She was a loving and devoted mother, a very kind and gentle spirit, and was first in line to help anyone in need.
