Miriam Dickinson Connelly, 99, of Morganton, NC passed away Wednesday, August 9, 2017. Born in Wilson, NC on February 18, 1918, she was the daughter of the late Judge Oscar Paul Dickinson and Daphne Lamm Dickinson. Miriam was preceded in death by 2 brothers, Oscar Paul Dickinson, Jr. and William Thomas Dickinson; and a sister, Dorothy Dickinson Farmer. After graduating from Atlantic Christian College in Wilson, Miriam moved to Morganton in 1939 where she taught school with Morganton Public Schools.
