

Mr. Clarence Gold Digh

March 4, 1920 - Aug. 2, 2006

Mr. Clarence Gold Digh, 86, of Admore Heights Dr., Valdese, NC died Wednesday, August 2, 2006 at Memorial Mission Hospital in Asheville from injuries sustained in an auto accident. Mr. Digh was born on March 4, 1920 in Cleveland County and was a son of the late John Cletus Digh and Nettie Rhoney Digh. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers, Paul, Solen, and Fonz Digh, and two sisters, Beulah Mae Digh and Mabel Stewart.
