Mrs. Mary Browning Crooks, 103, of Cleveland, TN died Sunday, September 1, 2013. She was born on Paddy's Creek, Burke County, NC on July 2, 1910 and was a life-long member of Oak Grove Baptist Church. Mary was married to John C. Crooks who preceded her in death by 42 years.
