Ned Rumfelt, 84, of Morganton, NC passed away Monday, July 17, 2017. Born in Burke County, NC on December 12, 1932, he was the son of the late Joseph P. Rumfelt and Martha Biggerstaff Rumfelt. Ned retired from the U.S. Air Force after 20 years, having served in the Korean War. He later worked for the Burke County Sheriff's Department and as a farmer and truck driver.

A loving husband, Ned is survived by his wife, Doris Chambliss Rumfelt of the home; a brother, Homer Rumfelt and wife, Janice, of Marion, NC; and a number of nieces, nephews, great-nieces, and great-nephews.
