Nina Faye Thompson Anderson, 93, of Morganton, NC, passed away Thursday, August 13, 2026.

Born in Burke County, NC on January 17, 1933, she was the daughter of the late William Vance Thompson and Bessie Louise Clontz Thompson.

Nina was a longtime member of Oak Hill United Methodist Church. She taught first and second grade children's Sunday school for more than 25 years, was active in the United Methodist Women, was a member of the Mabel Harbison Sunday School Class, and was a member of the Do Your Own Thing group.
