Phillip Harvey Davis, 87, of Morganton died Friday, March 2, 2018. Born in Burke County, NC on January 24, 1931, he was the son of the late Edward Webb Davis and Ezzel Moultrie Cox Davis.

Phillip was a member of Oak Hill United Methodist Church. He served as a medic with the U.S. Army on the front lines of the Korean War. Mr. Davis retired from Carolina Container Corp of Hickory and was well-known in the Laotian community as the "Cow Man."
