Priscilla Mary Moore, 90, of Morganton, NC passed away peacefully on Thursday, November 29, 2018. Born in Utica, NY on January 14, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Wallace Ladd Owens and Ada Mary Burton Owens.

After graduating from Potsdam State Teachers College, Priscilla pursued a teaching career in Early Childhood Education in Utica. Her favorite memories of that time included catching frogs for frog legs, boating, and learning to swim. She fulfilled her dream of living at the lake when she built her home on Lake James. There she enjoyed swimming and water-skiing with her family. Priscilla loved the lake and passed that love on to her sons and grandson.
