Robert Bruce "Bob" Sisk, 93, of Morganton passed away at home on the Sisk Farm at the foot of his beloved Table Rock Mountain on Tuesday, February 19, 2019. Born in Burke County, NC on September 3, 1925, he was the son of the late Rev. Beattie Avery Sisk and Lillie Belle McGimsey Sisk. He was a member of Mountain Grove United Methodist Church for over 70 years.

The son of a Methodist minister, he lived in various areas across the state. While in Greensboro he met the love of his life, Martha Elizabeth Martin Sisk, to whom he was married for 73 years.
