Roger Walter Moon, 72, of Morganton, NC passed away, Monday, August 28, 2023. Born on August 4, 1951, he was the son of the late Shelley Walter and Alta Rutledge Moon. Roger was a member of First Baptist Church of Morganton. He received his undergraduate degree from Greensboro College and went on to receive his Master's in Rehabilitation Psychology from Appalachian State University. Roger retired as the Western Region Director, NC Division of Prisons. For the past several years, he served as the General Manager of Mimosa Hill Golf Club. Roger loved spending time with his friends and family and playing golf.
