Roy Thomas Waters, Sr., 86, of the Salem Community, Morganton passed away Sunday, November 3, 2019. Born in Buncombe County, NC on May 8, 1933, he was the son of the late Albert Ernest Waters and Annie Bowman Waters. Roy was a former deacon and Sunday school teacher of Pleasant Ridge Baptist Church.
