Ruth Cheney Hogshead, 93, of West Park Drive, Morganton, NC died Saturday, August 10, 2013 at Grace Hospital. Born in Morgan, GA on October 11, 1919, she was the daughter of the late Clifford William Cheney and Tete Weaver Cheney.
