Sarah "Geneva" Duckworth Reinhardt, 99, of Morganton, NC, died Tuesday, February 20, 2024.

Born in Burke County, NC on May 19, 1924, she is the daughter of the late Zero and Sara Byrd Mull.

Geneva was a member of Mt. Home Baptist Church. She married her husband on May 20, 1940, and together they had three children and adopted one.

Geneva held many upstanding positions throughout her career.
