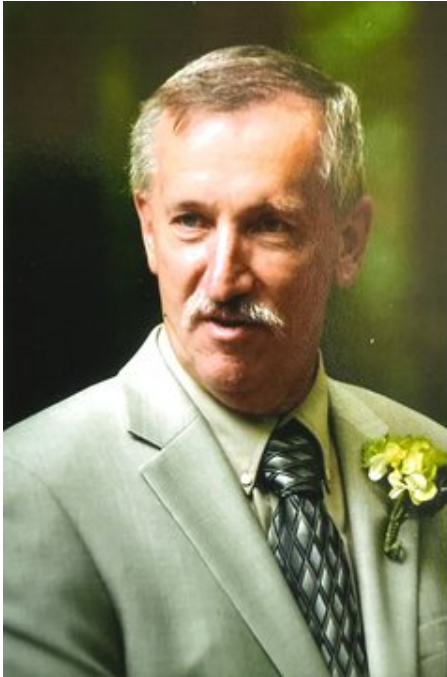




Stephen Andrew "Steve"

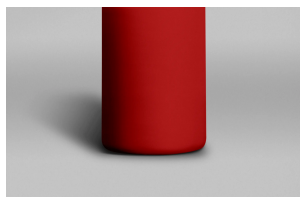
