Tom Cook, 85, of Morganton, NC died Monday, October 8, 2012 at Grace Hospital following several months of declining health. Born March 10, 1927 in McDowell County, NC, he was a son of the late Charlie Andrew Cook and Essie Mae Taylor Cook. Tom was a US Navy veteran of World War II, and a member of Burkemont Baptist Church where he had taught adult Sunday school class.
